Note - (i) The eligible failure students of 09-Batch and those students who were initially admitted with 09-Batch but were re-admitted with lower batch(es) are required to submit the examination form(s) alongwith the AFFIDAVIT on the judicial Stamp paper worth Rs. 100/- to the effect that they will pay double examination fee(s), they will not claim any grace mark(s) and they will not request for any further supplementary examination or any other concession at all. They will not approach the University authorities to process any application for Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council. (For Engineering Students only) and they will not claim any right for Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council at any time in a court of law/legal forum etc. (For Engineering Students only) The specimen of the Affidavit is available in the office of the Chairman concerned teaching department/Co-ordinator BS(CS) Programme

1. Eligible candidates are required to present themselves in the examination Hall / Room 15 minutes before the time fixed for Theory & Practical examination. 2. Eligible candidates are required to bring their ADMIT SLIP at the time of Examination. The candidates without ADMIT SLIP shall not be allowed to appear in the Examination. 3. The appearance of INELIGIBLE candidates in the Examination shall be illegal as such the result of concerned subject(s) shall automatically stand cancelled without issuing any letter. 4. All eligible candidates MUST refrain to bring any sort of written material & Mobile Phone in the Examination Hall/Room during the conduct of Theory & Practical Examination. 5. Eligible candidates MUST read carefully the INSTRUCTIONS written on ADMIT SLIP for strict compliance.
2. **Note. Special Instructions for Students & Staff.** 1. Students / Candidate be allowed to enter in the examination hall only wearing facemasks. 2. Before entering to examination hall all are advised to wash/ sanitize hands. 3. Social distance of at least 3'-0" (three feet) shall be maintained. 4. Gathering at entrance or in examination centre be avoided. 5. All invigilators/ staff must perform hand hygiene frequently with soap and water or hand sanitizer. 6. Avoid handshakes/ hugs. 7.
